Children should choose one task from each box, both if they wish and hand in their homework by the date at the top of the box. In addition to this, children will receive weekly maths homework, spellings and are expected to read 5 times a week.

Week 1 and 2

To be handed in 18/09/2017

Find out why and how the Egyptians mummified their dead?



Week 3 and 4

To be handed in 02/10/2017

Record ten interesting facts about present day or ancient Egypt.

Create a menu for a rich ancient Egyptian banquet.

Week 5 and 6

To be handed in 13/10/2017

Make Tutankhamen's death mask.


Either design and create sarcophagus fit for a pharaoh.

Draw and paint an important event in the style of the ancient Egyptian wall paintings (hieroglyphics).

Each piece of work is worth 25 points with up to 150 points available for completing above homework tasks.

Pupils can get up to 150 points for quality and presentation.
