Curricular Information

- Literacy

In literacy lessons we will be developing our writing skills by finding out how to write labels, lists and signs, We will look at writing commands and also explore poems that have patterns and rhymes.

We will continue to learn new spellings weekly and have daily handwriting lessons.

- Numeracy

Children will be counting, reading and writing numbers up to 20. We will also be looking at halves and how to halve an object or quantity. We will learn about the coins and notes that make up the money we use.

- Science

Children will be exploring the Seasons and the weather associated with each season.

- ICT

Children will be continue to look at algorithms and how to program a sandwich making 'robot'

- Art

We will learn how to make collage from paper and use chalk to express our experiences. We will also print repeating patterns.

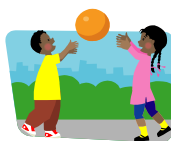
- DT
