1. Find out about a celebration from another country. What is the celebration called? How do the people of that country celebrate?

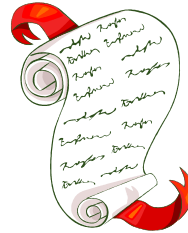
