mammals

An animal that is covered in hair or fur. The female gives birth to live young and feeds her babies with milk from her own body.

fish

An animal that lives in the water and has gills and fins

reptiles

An animal that has dry, scaly skin and lays eggs on land

carnivore

An animal that only eats other animals

herbivore

An animal that only eats plants

omnivore

An animal that eats both plants and other animals

diet

The kind of food an animal eats.

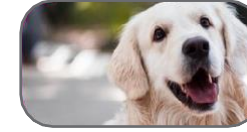
