If your child would like a book please come to the fire door off the playground with the fixed football/basketball nets and opposite the bandstand (the playground where Year 4 and 6 are collected).

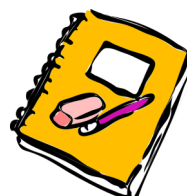
