Terrific Tales!



Our topic for this half-term is 'Terrific Tales' We will be immersing ourselves in lots of familiar stories including Goldilocks, The Gingerbread Man and other Winter stories. Your child will be encouraged to join in with rhymes, use new vocabulary and develop play around stories using puppets and props. They will also start to ask questions, share their own ideas and identify characters and events in a book they listen to.

In maths, we will be continuing to sing songs and count reliably to five or more and be able to show 'finger numbers' to three. We will be exploring and selecting appropriate 2D and 3D shapes to build with, combine to make new shapes and create patterns. In addition, we will be talking about the days of the week and seasons and starting to sequence daily events.
