English and Maths:

This term will primarily be spent preparing the children for the SATs examinations. We will be using a variety of revision materials, including past papers and published revision guides, to ensure that the children achieve their full potential in the end of KS2 assessments. Excellent attendance is obviously crucial during this period of preparation. The timetable for the SATs exams is as follows:

Thursday 14th May 2026	Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 3) - 40 minutes

Preparation for SATs Exams: As you will know by now, the school has subscribed to a SATs revision website that offers a revision programme which would be useful for the children to follow. There are lots of useful revision activities which your child can access from home by going to the website www.satsbootcamp.co.uk and using their individual login details. The Mathswatch website that the children have been using for homework is also useful as it has videos and activities which are good for revision. In addition, the school has purchased Maths revision guides and question books which have been given to the children.

History: The children will be studying a history topic about the Maya Civilization.

RE: The children will be exploring what Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people?

Science: The children will name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

Reading: Please continue to encourage your child to read at home and test their comprehension of what they have read.

PE Kits: Please note that children should continue to wear their PE kit on a Friday. The topic this half term is basketball.

Homework will continue to be set as follows:

Grammar will be given on Monday and should be completed by Wednesday. Spellings will be given on Tuesday and tested on Friday. Maths will be given on Wednesday and should be completed by Friday. Reading Comprehension will be given on Friday and should be completed by Monday.
